

Plastic Club Gelli Plate Jam:
What You Can Do With Gel Printing Plates
Sunday, January 20th, 1:00 PM – 4:00 PM

There are countless ways for making prints or collage papers with Gel printing plates. Bring your Gel plate, acrylic paints, inks, print and deli papers and other supplies, including 2-4 inch soft brayers, paper towels, spray bottle, texture “tools”; templates; and palette knives.

Share your methods or simply come and learn how others are creating with this simple and enjoyable way of making monoprints and collage papers.

The session will start with a few short, basic demonstrations including how to create single and multiple color prints and texture prints. In addition, there will be a demonstration using larger Gelli plates. These and other techniques will be summarized in a brief handout. Then you start making your own prints as well as learn more techniques from others attending the workshop.

Note: The Club will also charge its usual workshop fee: \$8.00 (\$7.00 for members). There is also a \$10.00 fee if you are using shared supplies. These supplies include 6x6 Gelli plate; acrylic paints; archival paper as well as deli and Xerox paper for ghost prints; texture materials; and brayers.
