The Workshop Show

As always, the show in June was devoted to work done in our workshops by workshop participants. There is no fee for this show. We are happy to show the great work done in the workshops (now there are 10) by Plastic Club members and non-members. This year we had 100 works on the walls. There is no single juror. Rather, there are many jurors. Participants are asked to "vote" by choosing the number of a work and putting it into a ballot box anonymously. The creator of the work that gets the most votes gets a free pass at four workshops.


